FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How did I become a fabric designer? I began after many years of sewing and painting and preparing myself by refining my style and my abilities. I became interested in creating artwork for fabric many years before I actually did it. I began by getting myself a portfolio of designs that I had created that coordinated and could be used for quilting cotton. I put the designs into 3 colorways, printed them up, and took them to quilt market in Houston one year. I showed my portfolio to several of the fabric manufacturers, and acquired several offers. At that point I had to choose which company I wanted to go with. It did require a lot of work to get ready, I didn't really know what I was doing, but I just went for it! Many years of sewing and drawing and painting, combining colors and designing my own clothes and home decor all added to my success in this industry so far. It is a wonderful creative outlet for me, but it requires much more work than I ever imagined!
